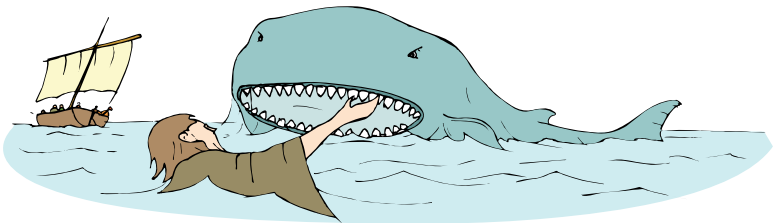
Minus -the year you were born

A grateful member

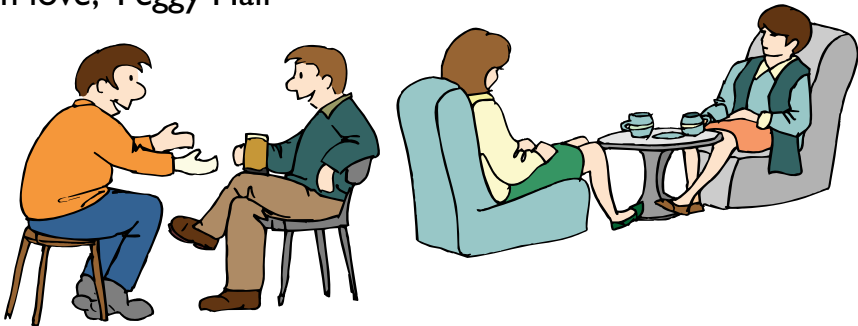
I would just like to give my grateful thanks to our wonderful dedicated Leadership Team who work so hard and yet so-together preparing each Sunday's worship.
